Diploma Requirements

English (4 credits)

9th Grade Lit./Comp. to include literature, composition, and grammar

10th Grade Lit./Comp. to include literature, composition, and grammar

11th and 12th Grade English\* may be World Lit./Comp, American Lit./Comp., and/or British Lit./Comp.

\* Alternatively, the student may take English 1101 and English 1102 through DE for the third and fourth English credits.

Math (4 credits )

Algebra I

Geometry

Algebra II

Con. Math

Advanced Math\*\* such as Pre-calculus or Calculus, taken either at home or as part of dual enrollment (DE)

\*\*College Algebra, Statistics, Pre-calculus, or Calculus may be taken as the fourth math through DE

**Math classes completed prior to high school do not count toward the four math credits.**

Social Studies (4 credits)

World History

U.S. History

American Gov't. (0.5 credits unless taken through DE)

Economics (0.5 credits unless taken through DE)

Additional Social Studies course such as Psychology, Sociology, or additional history classes through DE

Science (4 credits)

Physical Science, if it has not been taken prior to high school, and the curriculum is high school level; this may take the place of Physics if student is not a science, technology, engineering, math (STEM) student. It may not be taken after completion of Biology and Chemistry.

Advanced Biology, Chemistry, or Physics, or alternative science such as Astronomy, Environmental Science, Geology, etc.

Foreign Language (2 credits)

2 years of the same language required

Spanish, French, German, Japanese, Greek, Latin, American Sign Language (ASL), etc.

Physical Education/Health (1 credit) — 0.5 credit each

Minimum of 5 electives- chosen from any area of interest (Many accredited homeschoolers design curriculums based on their students' needs and interests beyond state requirements earning them more than the 24 credits required for graduation.)

**PLEASE NOTE:**

To be eligible for the HOPE scholarship, the student must earn a minimum of **four** credits from the following list (<https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/hope-zell-miller-scholarships/hope-scholarship/eligibility/academic-rigor-requirements/>.)

1. Advanced math, such as Algebra II or pre-calculus, taken at the high school, or an equivalent or higher course taken through dual enrollment;
2. Advanced science, such as Chemistry II, Physics II, or Biology II, taken at the high school, or an equivalent or higher course taken through dual enrollment;
3. Foreign language courses taken at the high school, or taken for degree level credit through dual enrollment;
4. Advanced Placement or dual enrollment courses in core subjects.
